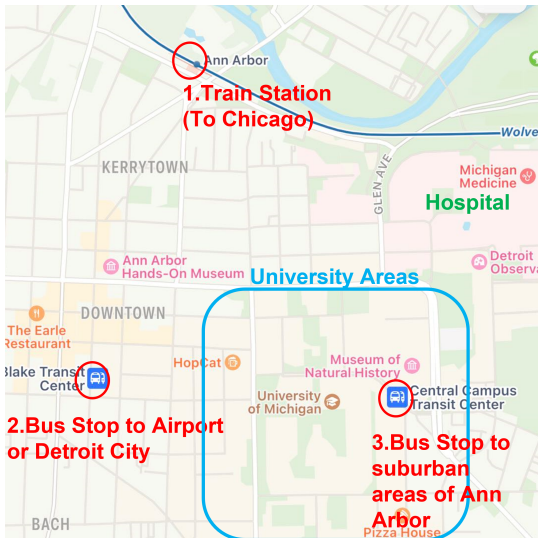

# Supermarkets

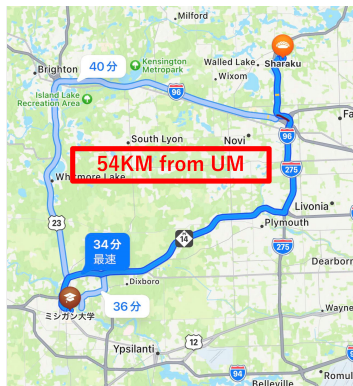
- Close to University: Target (middle-size supermarket)

Here are some additional tips:
